Dear Homeowner,

We hope this letter finds you well.

A Notice to Submit a planning application for the proposed Knockshanvo Wind Farm will be published in the Clare Champion, the Limerick Leader and the Irish Independent newspapers this week. A separate notice for the associated grid connection will also be published in parallel.

Planning notices will be erected and displayed around the project site for this development. The application will be submitted by Knockshanvo Wind DAC.

When An Bord Pleanála has received and validated the planning applications, the full suite of planning application documentation, including the Environmental Impact Assessment Report (EIAR), will be uploaded and available to view at [www.knockshanvoplanning.ie](http://www.knockshanvoplanning.ie), [www.knockshanvogridplanning.ie](http://www.knockshanvogridplanning.ie) and at [www.pleanala.ie](http://www.pleanala.ie). A hard copy of the planning application and EIAR will also be available at the offices of An Bord Pleanála, Clare County Council and Limerick County Council.

There is a useful FAQ section on An Bord Pleanála's website that provides guidance on public participation. Any person or body may make observations on the project to An Bord Pleanála after the applications have been submitted. The timeframe to make an observation is seven weeks. To give you an indication of the planning decision timeline, on average it is taking 12 to 18 months for a decision to be made on wind energy projects.

We will keep you up to date with any further news.
